- Thanks all, and I'm sure it will be a good year.

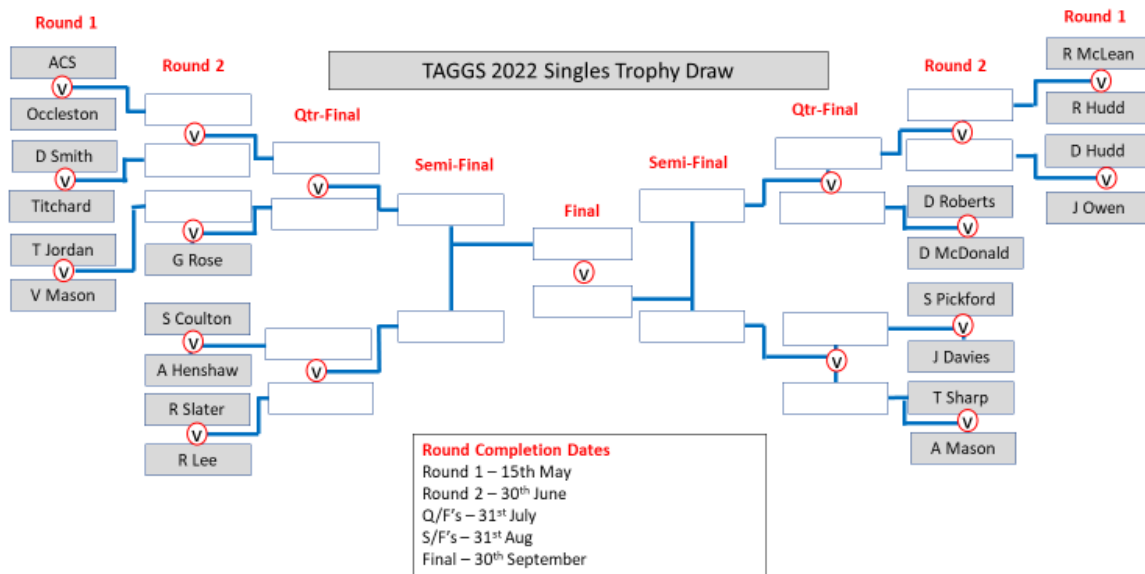
