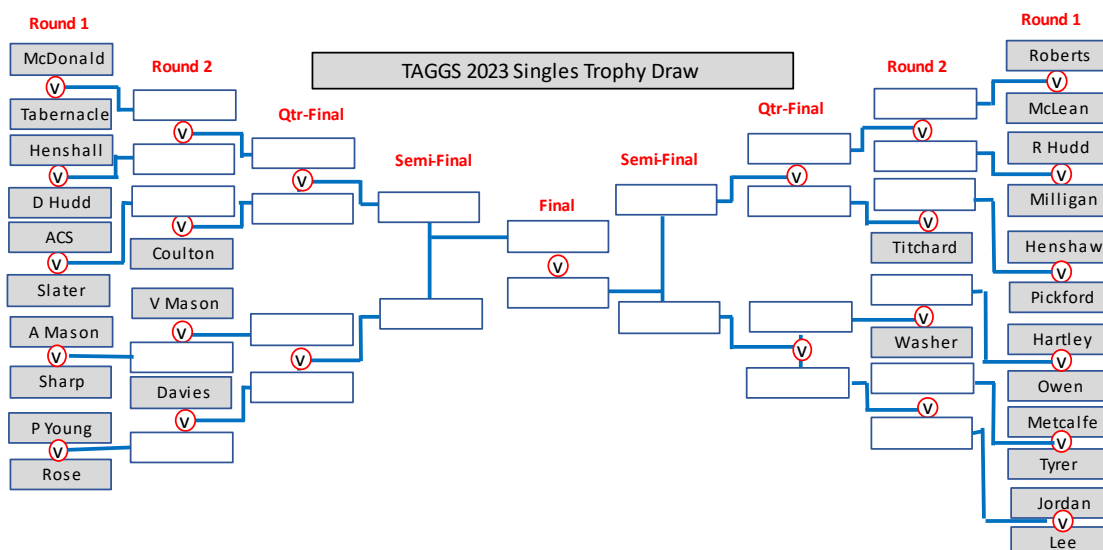
Charity
