Costs £77 (inc 2’s)

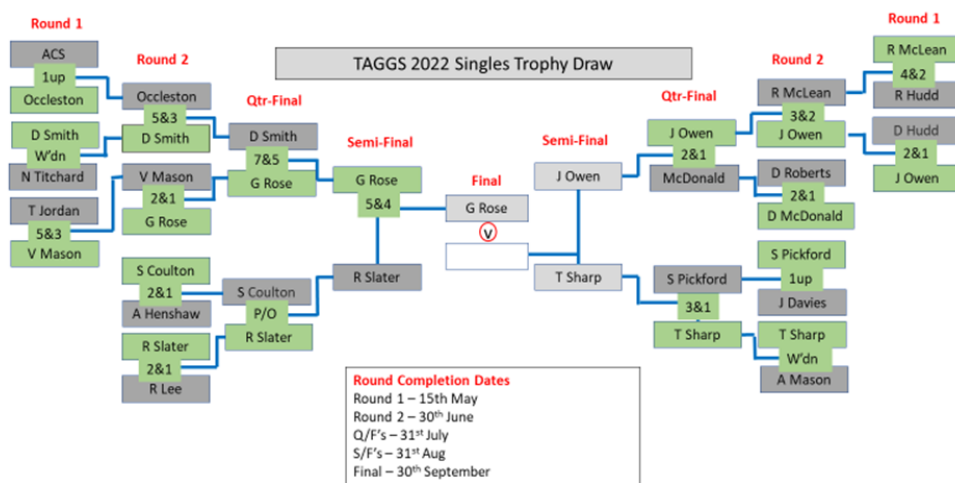
